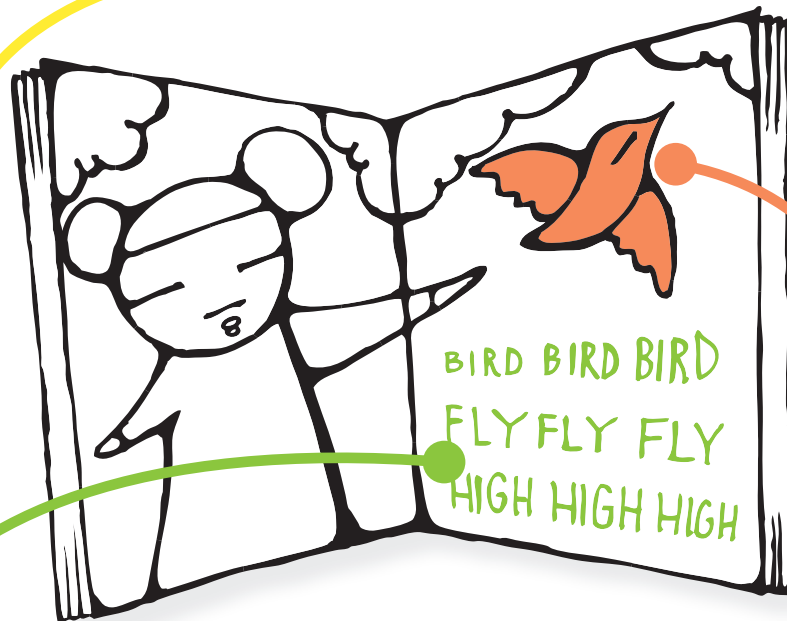


Who's Involved in Making a Picture Book?



Publisher

The one who owns the ISBN of the book and distributes it to be sold.
Hires/Contracts work from everyone below



Author

Takes care of the words
with the help of an:

Editor

works with Author to bring out their very best story
(sometimes a copy editor is hired to double check the text)

Book Designer

Brings the author's words and illustrator's art together to create the overall design of the book and the final computer files for the printer
with possible assistance from a:

Book Production Manager

Oversees the logistics of the printed book, such as scanning of artwork, checking for errors, and other book details

sometimes these are the same person!

*if these are different people, in traditional publishing settings, it is likely that they will never meet while the book art is being created and maybe never at all

Artist/ Illustrator

Takes care of the pictures

with the help of an:

Art Director

works with Artist to bring out their very best artwork

Printer

Turns the computer files into a printed bound book and prints the number of copies the publisher requests

sends all of the finished books to publisher to distribute and sell
